The Hameau Duboeuf opened its doors in 1993. This wine theme park revealed its origins and the secrets of its vineyards and wine-making techniques.

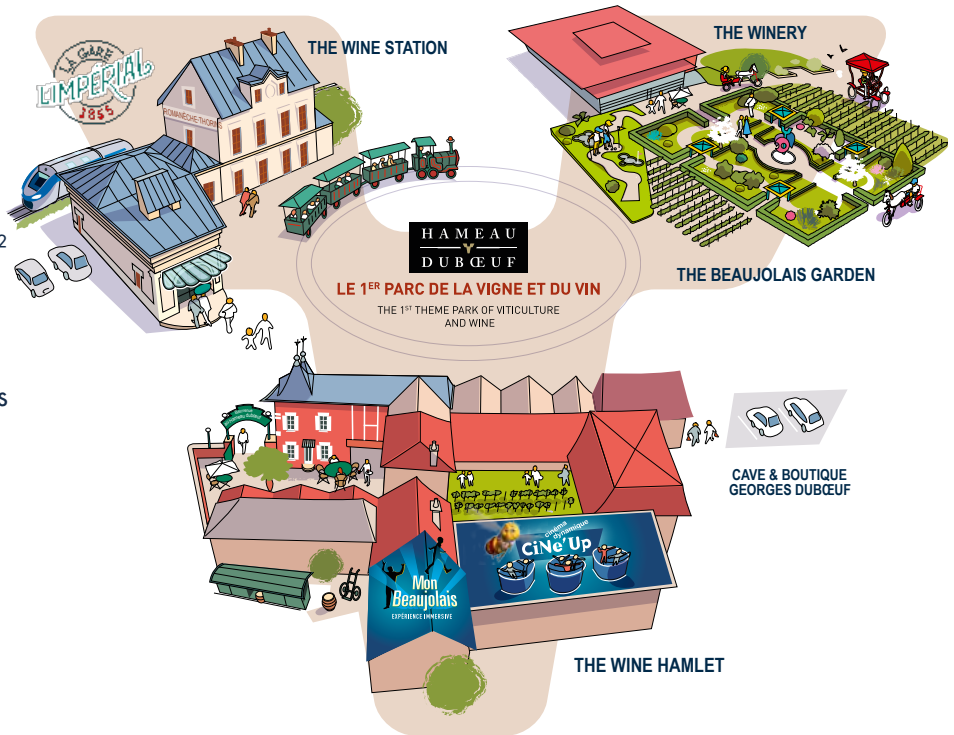

SUCH A WONDERFUL DAY AT HAMEAU DUBŒUF!

Created by Georges Duboeuf in 1993, Hameau Dubœuf is Europe's first theme park dedicated to vines and wine. Unique of its kind, it reveals the art of wine in a fun, educational and immersive way. Designed for the whole family, the park appeals to beginners, enthusiasts and connoisseurs alike.

Your visit begins in the Salle des Pas Perdus, a recreation of a 1900s-style railway hall, the starting point of your fascinating journey through 2,000 years of history. Along the way, discover the tools and winemaking techniques that have shaped the heritage of the Beaujolais and Mâconnais regions. Immersive animations enhance your experience with vibrant and captivating shows. Your journey will take you to the Limonaire room, where a wine tasting awaits you (or grape juice), before sitting down for a gourmet lunch at the Café des Deux Horloges.

After lunch, head to the Gare de l'Impérial and witness a historical encounter in front of the Napoleon III carriage. The show continues behind the scenes of a cabaret, where Bacchantes with crystal-clear voices rehearse their next performance.

During the warmer months, immerse yourself in the heart of winemaking and discover the scents of flowers, bark, fruits and spices that give wine its rich aromas in the Garden in Beaujolais. You can also explore this area through activities such as a Rosalie or sulky ride, or enjoy a round of mini-golf.

THE PLACE THAT TIME FORGOT



The “Salle des Pas Perdus” (Place that time forgot) is a reconstruction of a 1900s railway station hall. It features a mural painted by a Lyon-based artist, depicting the main appellations of Beaujolais, from the golden stone region to the southern Mâconnais. This is where your journey through 2,000 years of history begins.

The Wine Transport Hall traces the evolution of wine trade and distribution through the ages, from Prehistory to the present day.

THE MUSEOLOGY



With more than 3,000 objects, Hameau Dubœuf brings together a collection that retraces 2,000 years of winemaking history and evolution. Observe the tools and discover the techniques used by our ancestors to cultivate, care for and protect the vine.

Walk through the cellars dedicated to the aging of wines in oak barrels, such as Moulin-à-Vent for Beaujolais and Pouilly-Fuissé for Mâconnais wines.

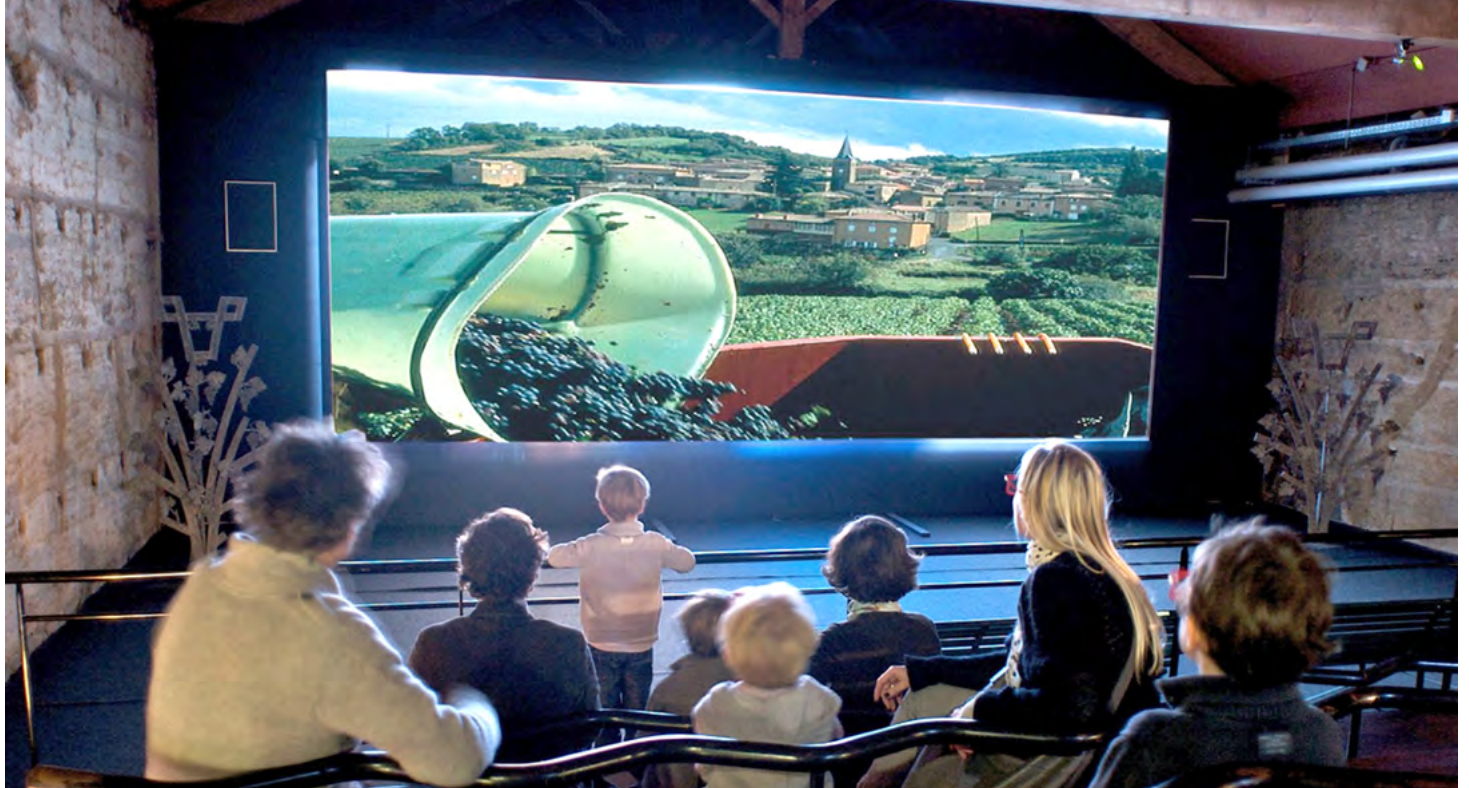

THE CRUS JOURNEY



An animated slideshow and an interactive map invite you to discover, with a touch of poetry, the crus of Beaujolais and Mâconnais.

THE 3D FILM "LA R'VOLE"



This 3D film, themed around the celebration marking the end of the harvest, features the renowned Bernard Pivot, Christian Marin, and the famous chef Paul Bocuse.

CINÉ'UP



Aboard moving pods synchronized with images projected onto two giant screens, discover the beauty of the Beaujolais and Mâconnais landscapes.

THE EXHIBITION HALL



Explore an exhibition of vintage advertising posters. These are original pieces, some dating back to the early 20th century. A wax museum also brings to life the personalities who have shaped the history of Beaujolais.

The visit continues with a presentation of the professions related to wine: winemaking, barrel making, glassmaking, and cork production.

The Georges Dubœuf winemaking center places visitors at the heart of wine production. Winemaking techniques are explained in this space that combines cutting-edge technology with respect for tradition, whether in the calm of the cellars or among 150 stainless steel tanks.

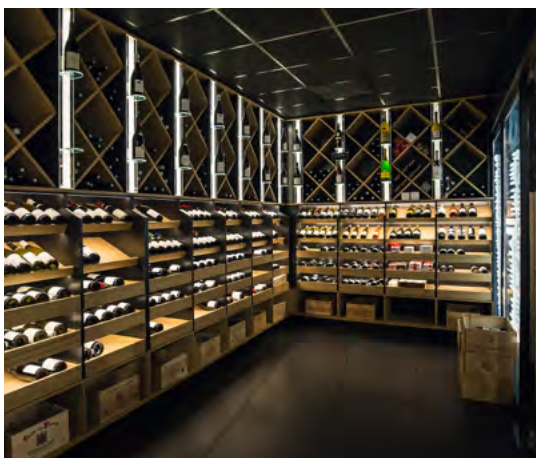

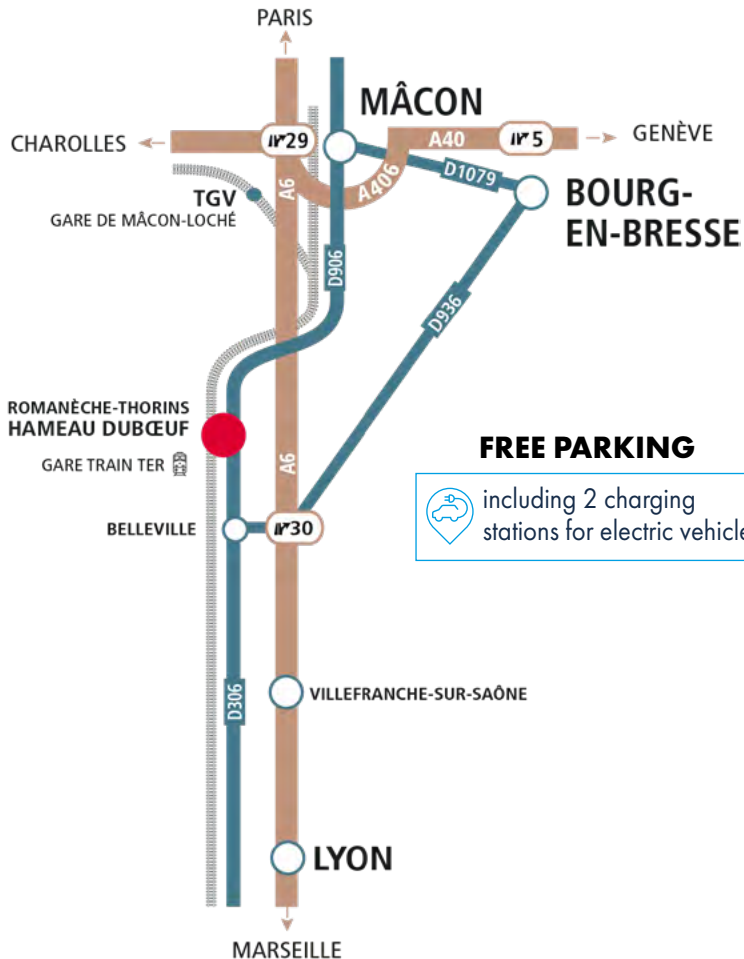
